PINOT NOIR "COLLEZIONE" VINTAGE 2010

DENOMINATION: Veneto I.g.t (Typical Geographic Indication) Pinot Noir
WINE TYPE: Red
GRAPES: Pinot Nero 100%
SOIL TYPE: Deep, Mainly Clayey, Mineral Rich, Well
Drained and Ventilated.
**TRAINING SYSTEM AND
PLANTING DENSITY:** Guyot, Spurred Cordon .6000 Vines/Hectare
HARVEST DATE: End of September/Beginning of October

TASTING NOTES: Pinot Nero, of Burgundian origin, has been cultivated in Veneto for many years , producing both sparkling and still wines.

A lively ruby red colour reminiscent of ripe cherries. Primary aromas of fresh woodland fruits are strongly evident on the nose, supported by the more complex aromas resulting from the oak ageing process, creating a full and intense bouquet. On the palate flavours of wild cherries create a perfect balance with the gentle tannins.

A wine with a purity of style with great ageing potential.
